Dear Parents,

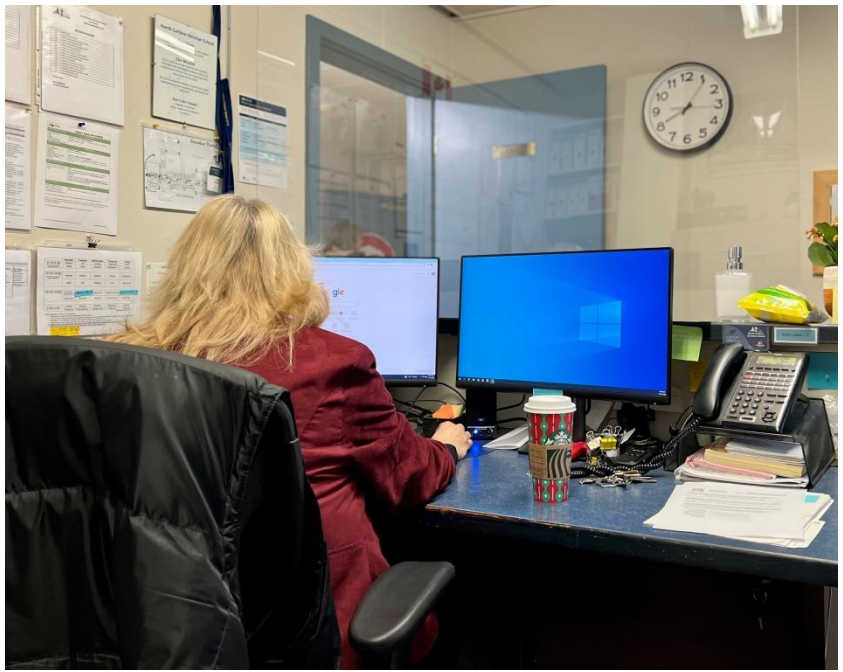
1 There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens:

Blessings on your retirement and may God bless you in the days ahead!

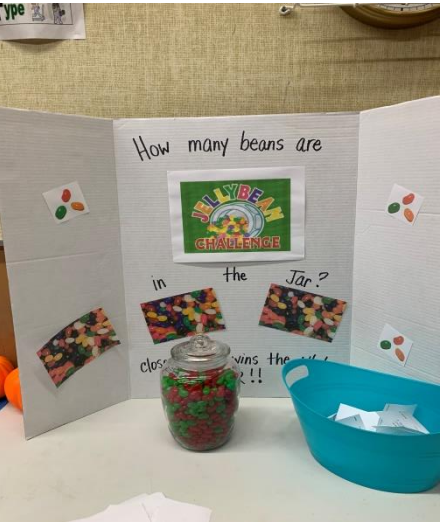

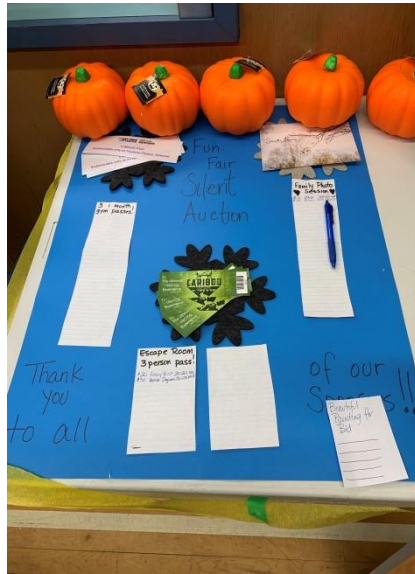
