Dear Parents,

As Christmas approaches and we prepare to celebrate, let's not forget amongst the various celebrations the reason for the season: Jesus' birth. Old Testament prophets spoke about the birth of Jesus. While many religions have recorded prophecy about various events, the crucial aspect of prophecy is the *fulfillment* of these events. For me, prophecy about Jesus is something that boosts my faith because it has *ALL* been fulfilled. And I am not talking one or two prophecies! Why, just looking at the prophecy surrounding the birth of Jesus there are easily 55 prophetic statements that have all come to pass exactly as the Bible says they will.

Here is one example:

Prophecy:

"Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel" (Isaiah 7:14).

Fulfillment:

"The angel answered, "The Holy Spirit will come on you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the holy one to be born will be called the Son of God" (Luke 1:35).

So when Christians speak of Christmas, we are proclaiming (as the angels did) Glory to God for unto us is born (as was prophesied), a Saviour!

We look forward to seeing you at our 1:00 or 6:30 Performances.



Grade 3/4 Nativity Silhouettes






The Grade 3/4 class has a tree with homemade ornaments!
