Forms are due today, December 18th

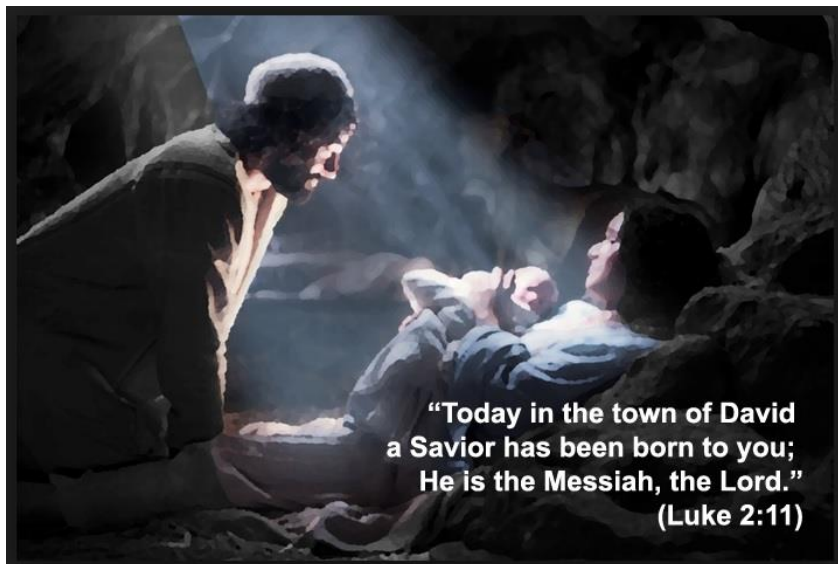
MARKETING & PROMO
